Informational Update on Temurin Release

- https://github.com/adoptium/adoptium/adoptium/issues/68 to track progress publicly
- 2 JRE's have been released on JDK8
- More secondary platforms are now out the door.
- The delay is primarily due to the lack of people available to run the tests.
 - New committers on the way!
- Samir asked if the coffee cup logo could be used when an application is bundled with a Temurin binary.
 - Third parties cannot use the coffee cup logo without a direct agreement with Oracle.
 - Third parties can use the Java Duke as it's under an open source license.
- Docker Hub images are available as well as homebrew casks.
- JRE's for 8 will be produced. Maybe for 11 and definitely not for JDK16+
 - o Recommend ilink instead
