Minutes

- **Approval of minutes from July 22, 2021 meeting**
 - Deferred until Eclipse Foundation attendees in attendance.
- **Approval of Minutes and Review of Actions from July 29, 2021**
 - Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.
- **Informational Update on Temurin Release**
 - Primary platforms for Linux, Windows, macOS all on Intel x86 for each of Temurin 8, 11, and 16 have been released.
 - Secondary platform testing underway, restricted by machine resource at present.

- Further work on Linux installers in progress, and a discussion of the repository hosting for these is pending. Potential to move from JFrog to Eclipse's Nexus repo.
- Docker images created and pull requests in place with Dockerhub to host them.
- Confirmation being sought for JRE releases beyond Temurin 8.
- Observation that there are a number of release scripts and associated scripts that are carrying technical debt.
- Discussion of the effort and priority for delivering JREs in the current release.
- Aarch64 and ppc64le platforms are near ready for release.
- **Adoptium Marketplace plan & uplift**
 - As work items for this release close out the focus will move to the marketplace.
 - Code branch shows idea of mock-up for the Adoptium marketplace website.
 - Work still required for AQAvit test passing policy. Version tag of code expected next week, together with expected workflow.
 - Discussion of the nature of the marketplace. While Eclipse would not be distributing the binaries directly, questions about whether vendors can directly manage the entries or if this is the responsibility of the WG remain.
 - Goal should be to bring up the marketplace concept as soon as possible. Having no marketplace leads people to assume Adoptium only promotes the community Temurin builds. The current homepage is sending the wrong message.
 - Shelley noted that there is work underway on website UX to include a Java user-centric landing page, to include not only marketplace but also encourage new Java users.
 - Group agreed to share ideas via mock-ups, pull requests, etc to show concrete ideas for direction.
- **Marketing subcommittee meeting**
 - Wish to start-up the meetings asap. Volunteers have been identified.
 - Any SC member can drop in on these meetings to observe.
 - Plan to have these at 14:00 - 14:30 BST Thursdays.
