Invoice of the logos

- Hendrik: EF wants a transfer agreement signed before being paid
 - Paul: EF wants to ensure that the agreement is signed first. It's standard Eclipse practice. This contract was signed by AdoptOpenJDK under agreed terms, and carried over to Eclipse. The Eclipse agreement is a new requirement.
 - Hendrik to direct the designer to the EF directly.
- Paul mentioned that there is an EF service that will design logos for free.

- Hendrik noted that the arrangement in place already covers multiple logos, so we will continue to use the same agency.
- Should we launch the website without a UI/UX overhaul?
 - Gil's opinion is that we need the Marketplace at a minimum. General agreement that having the binaries and a marketplace appear simultaneously would give the right message, and people are welcome to contribute to helping that happen.
