Commercial Support for Temurin (proposal document)

- Gil shared <u>Temurin Patches Name/version possible variants</u> with the group
- Several companies will likely want to provide commercial support for Temurin-based builds. How does a company provide a P1 fix that a user can drop in as a replacement?
- Gil discussed the pros and cons of including the LTS flag in the java -version output.
