APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES:

TEMURIN COMPLIANCE SYSTEM LOANER AGREEMENT (TCSLA):

OPENJDK VULNERABILITY GROUP

- Oracle have declined to proceed with an agreement on this.
