# Minutes for September 5th, 2023

### Approve Minutes of August 8, 2023 Meeting

Motion: Approve Minutes of August 8, 2023. Titouan moves and Manuel seconds. No objection to unanimous approval.

RESOLVED, the Steering Committee unanimously approved the Minutes of August 8, 2023 on September 5, 2023.

### **Charter Update**

Discussion on distinction between Strategic and Platinum members. Discussion on Platinum members emphasize commitment to the Working Group as opposed to the IDE. Wording to emphasize this distinction is accepted.

Discussion on downgrading from Platinum to Strategic membership. Wording accepted. No change to wording for Strategic members. Discussion on two representatives versus two votes for a single representative in the Platinum tier. Paul White emphasized consistency with the Eclipse Foundation governance model and Belgian law. Voting is undertaken by individuals, not companies. EF strong preference to accept composition as-is. Wording accepted.

Update to Supporter member wording. Participation in subcommittees may be requested, but decisions to accept such requests to be taken by the Steering Committee. Revised wording accepted.

Revision to annual fees scaling by corporate revenue. Revision accepted. Discussion on control rights, information rights and approval obligations. Paul White points to a lack of interference by the EF board on WG decisions. Change to governance structure would be a dramatic change. Input is sought on technical points of service agreements but dissemination of details must be in balance with privacy concerns.

Agreement to on-going discussion on transparency.

Agreement to vote on final updates at next SC meeting.

#### Sponsorship Update

Paul Buck. Presentation on use of Yatta Checkout and alternative approach. All proposals now on hold. Issues with VAT, terms and termination, transaction fees, security, maintenance of customized version, proprietary code. EF judgement is that they would not be able to find a way forward. Existing sponsorship page will continue to be improved.

Martin Lippert. What are the right next steps toward a checkout solution? Call for greater openness.

Manuel Bork. Reasons for failure on Yatta Checkout discussions still not fully understood. Agree with call for greater transparency. How can we avoid this in the future?
