Minutes for August 8th , 2023

Approve Minutes of July 25, 2023 Meeting

Motion: Approve Minutes of July 25, 2023. John moves and Manuel seconds. No objection to unanimous approval.

RESOLVED, the Steering Committee unanimously approved the Minutes of July 25, 2023 on August 8, 2023.

Charter Update:

- Sharon has the impression that more time is needed (people on holiday, comments on the charter...) to come to a vote for the charter update. We'll try again at the next meeting (in 2 weeks)
- Sharon reminds the members that a proxy for the vote can be provided to the WG.
- Sharon will share a Google drive link with the WG members soon.

EclipseCon:

- The [community day document](#) should probably be updated again. The last update was in May.
- Waiting for feedback from the EF for the swag order
- Sharon will double-check whether the WG has finished arrangements to get a room for Tuesday morning
- Max made a proposal IDE WG introduction slide
 - Hopefully by its first usage we'll have accepted the charter and be able to put in the platinum members next to our strategic members
 - Would be good to also put in non strategic/platinum members on the slide
 - It's unclear what "our and your benefit" refers to, maybe we want to rephrase it and make clear what exactly we mean by "benefit"
- Sharon mentions that we can pre-book a BoF on Tuesday evening

Security issue - platform dev mailing list:

- The EF security team is trying to improve the IDE's security process
 - They have a few security experts and they wonder how we would handle, e.g., a critical vulnerability that would be disclosed before an official SimRel release. Can the IDE do an "emergency release"
 - Even if a SimRel emergency release would be released, that doesn't mean that everyone using a project with a critical vulnerability would update (as project's can be installed individually, free from SimRel)
 - It's mentioned that there is a lack of leadership for the platform. Noone released an official answer in name of the platform
 - Oomph can broadcast messages to its users to warn them about security issue
 - Maybe a central policy should be made by/for the platform on which other projects can add input. The platform looks like the logical choice for a first project with such a policy. The policy could then tickle down to the projects.

 - There’s also an “EclipseIDE” logo if that might be more appropriate. Marketing would need to be involved to change our logo
