Mikael Barbero (Eclipse Foundation) gave a summary of the RFP process that is being undertaken for the Security code audit of Equinox p2.

<https://ostif.org/> are doing the audit. The audit is not just running some automatic tools. There will be a report given to the Eclipse Foundation, privately if there are security concerns. In addition guidance will be provided to the projects, but the projects will be responsible for actual fix implementations.
