Minutes

Approve Minutes of Nov 29, 2022 Meeting

Motion: Approve Minutes of Nov 29, 2022. Johannes moves and Manuel seconds. No objection to unanimous approval.

RESOLVED, the Steering Committee unanimously approved the Minutes of Nov 29, 2022 on December 13, 2022

Welcome new member

Mark welcomes Sigasi as our new steering committee member.

Sigasi uses Eclipse IDE as part of the main product for 14 years, and likes to get involved strategically.

Next steps member acquisition: Slides

Sharon shows updated slides. Main update: Some numbers showing Eclipse IDE KPIs (slide 12).

Mark suggests adding time frames to these KPIs (yearly / quarterly / all time).

Sharon asks to look at the slides after the meeting (feedback, suggestions for improvement, ...) - just comment on the slides.

Next steps member acquisition: Membership pipeline / lead list

Mark invites the steering committee members to add their names to the lead list and to join sales activities for the corresponding companies. Paul is leading these sales activities.

Lead list was originally created when the Working Group was founded, so it may be outdated.

John wants to add a few more companies that might be missing.

Development Effort

Sharon gives an update on the several issues:

- m2e integration: Statement of work received, services contract in progress
- Transparency / website: ticket moved from marketing team to working group

Extending Sponsorship Initiative

- Sharon: Eclipse Foundation focused on board meeting tomorrow. Wrapping up things now (e.g., backoffice requirements), update to Yatta end of this week / beginning next week. Intend to split tasks. Goal: Agree on shared timeline for realization.
- Ed talks about discussion in Planning Council. No objections wrt the initiative, detailed notes in meeting minutes of the meeting.
- Pradeep: Is the time frame wrt release in March 2023 in danger? Ed thinks it's not, can be included in (and decided by) EPP.

Future JDT plans and priorities

Jonah: Productive call with interested parties. Could result in a positive impact in the first quarter 2023.

Chromium integration

Jonah summarizes activities. Yatta working on it (self-funded). Discussion in Planning Council if browser needs to have internet access or not (implications on security, updates, ...). The alternative solution is the commercial implementation, which is currently not available for open source use.
