New Code of Conduct and Communication Channels

Manuel commented from Yatta's point of view on the recently presented plans of the Eclipse Foundation management to further develop the Eclipse Sponsorships on their own. He expresses surprise that the EF management was proceeding here without mandate from the Working Group. He also stated that the action contradicts the Working Group's November 2022 Resolution. Purpose of the Resolution was, in his view, to leverage the potential of Yatta

Checkout for Eclipse IDE through the sponsorships - and vice versa.

Notwithstanding this, he made clear that Yatta continues to stand by its offer to use Yatta Checkout to process, improve and expand Eclipse Sponsorships, both "in-app" and at

eclipse.org, as last offered.

Mark will schedule a meeting with Paul for the Eclipse Foundation to clarify the issue and to

discuss how to proceed.
