# Minutes for May 14, 2024

# Approve Minutes of April 30, 2024 Meeting

# **Regular Steering Committee Update**

Thomas is in the JCON conference and on vacation. Hence, Mark updated on his behalf. Thomas is doing marketing work at JCON and it has generated quite an interest about ongoing works in Eclipse IDE in the conference.

## **Contributor Mentor Update**

Again, Mark updated on behalf of Thomas - going well with Hannes as expected. Manoj mentioned that one David contacted and connected to Thomas - whether it's full time or part time is not known.

# Initiation of an IDE WG Community Call

Mark mentioned that the community call is on June 4th and has volunteered to update on the program plan and also asked for suggestions. Max mentioned that this should have an introduction of Thomas followed by demos. Martin was curious as to who the expected audience in terms of would be - the users and or contributors leading to the discussion on a combined agenda of showcasing our features, initiatives as well asking for contributions from the audience. Ed suggested that we could demo the "cool new find dialog". Manoj thought that we could have this something similar to a community day albeit in a shorter form. ## SAP community day

Sebastian and Yannic updated on the same to suggest the dates to be Wed 10th and Thur 11th of the June.
