Minutes for January 9, 2024

Web browser integration

Continued discussions about browser integration

An alternative option might be Edge integration into Eclipse but this is only in the idea phase.

We'll discuss the vision first at the next face to face (27 February) and see if and how web browser integration fits into the story.

Top priorities

- Releng support has been extended with Ed Merks
- Secure installation layout progressed differently as expected, Christoph will rephrase what he's done and what can be done
- Windows defender: a PR has been created
- Eclipse.ini: work will start this month
- In talks with vogella to do wiki modernization and migration
- Extend Christoph for releng of critical components

SimRel project prioritization

SWT has gotten some bad publicity lately, we should respond in some way. Ed has used the list to create a report showing liveliness of the projects needed by WG members. Simrel is doing

well, the current members are proactive and quickly adapting changes. Ed will review dependencies of the highest rated projects and make sure they have recent dependencies with sources. Report will be placed with the simrel markdown files.

Marketing

We have a LinkedIn account and Sharon made sure we have a modern banner. Now we should start using it. For now, only Eclipse marketing has access, Sharon will look into whether anyone from the WG can get access.

AOB

Manoj: IBM has a new member that will start contributing to SWT, but there are no reviewers left over in the project. Maybe we should identify the most recent active contributors and maybe motivate them to become committers. Noone's working on the GTK4 port either and this will come back to bite us. Windows is also outdated, win32 is no longer recent. We only get away with that because Windows has extreme backward compatibility. **Please look inside your own company whether we've got any expertise we can miss.**

Yannic mentions that the <u>Eclipse matrix server</u> could use a channel to unite Eclipse contributors. Discuss again next time to get to an actionable.

Johannes is running for contributing member and Ed will run for committer member to the Eclipse Foundation board.
