 - Monthly paid
 - Each party allowed to terminate with short notice
 - Expect contract work to average about 60hrs a month
 - He averaged around 60hrs last year
 - He has signed but waiting for our signature
 - Art has started work
 - A month is short notice kostiantyn.kirenko@st.com asked
 - It is not a time and materials contract but a fixed budget contract john.kellerman@eclipse-foundation.org
 - What are the safeguards to stop him working 1 hr but get paid for 1 monthkostiantyn.kirenko@st.com
