John K wants the group to collect input, what work the Eclipse foundation should do on behalf of membership, this will feed into program plan discussion

Hans says it depends on volume, Konstantin says we start with a page and then transition to Github, P0 for Konstantin is to verify the Open VSX is reliable, Hans agrees that it is what he tried to convey in his slide, Tracy concurs that what Konstantin wants is what we should do

John K proceeds to share something we might not be aware of <https://status.open-vsx.org> He stresses there is an API for better uptime. He agrees we all want stable, reliable platform, work needs to be done to shore up what we have. He wants to get us better reports as a group.

Konstantin remarks that 98.5 uptime showed is 2hrs of downtime a week which gives room for improvement to 99.9.

Hans brings up proposal to start with a doc for now to record what we need to do. Proposal passed, decision taken. Hans offers to start the Google doc after Konstantin begs off stating he is busy the next 2 weeks.
