Minutes 4/09/2024

- A quorum was established
- Minutes from last meeting (2024-03-26) were approved unanonymously
- [John] presented Antitrust Guidelines (see the link above)
 - Important points to avoid were presented
 - If there are any questions, the proposition is to refer to license@eclipse.org
- [John] and [Konstantin] were presenting the latest updates from the development and support
 - Graphana monitoring is being set up
 - Eclipse Foundation IT confirms that there are no alerts from ElasticSearch anymore
 - [Konstantin] mentioned that the statistics presented by John are very useful
 - [John] is going to show the statistics approximately once per quarter
 - The service looks much more stable recent 3 months
- [John] presented his ongoing efforts to find new participants to OpenVSX
 - John is in the search for a sustainable model for funding the service
 - Searching for a new model to engage people maybe in a format different from the full Working Group membership
 - Maybe there could be some members which will pay less, and will not be so involved in all the activities, but still have some influence to the service and receiving some benefits
 - [Konstantin] described a white labeling idea
 - The idea is to provide an OpenVSX logical instances with an address like <company-name>.open-vsx.org
 - The company will have an exclusive rights to publish to own instance, to manage users, and so on
 - The instance will be run using established Eclipse Foundation IT infrastructure
 - [Denis], [John], [Johannes] and [Tom] participated in the discussion, making questions about the details
 - [Denis] asked about relations between a whitelabeled instance and the main one.
 There are still details to clarify, because it is just an idea at the moment
 - [Tom] mentioned in particularly that it will be good to engage everybody interested in OpenVSX in some way
 - [Konstantin] proposed another idea to John, to contact big players which creating solutions based on Theia for any sponsorship
 - Such companies could contribute with money or with their cloud infrastructure



 [Denis] mentioned that it is important to avoid the vendor lock while using cloud services
