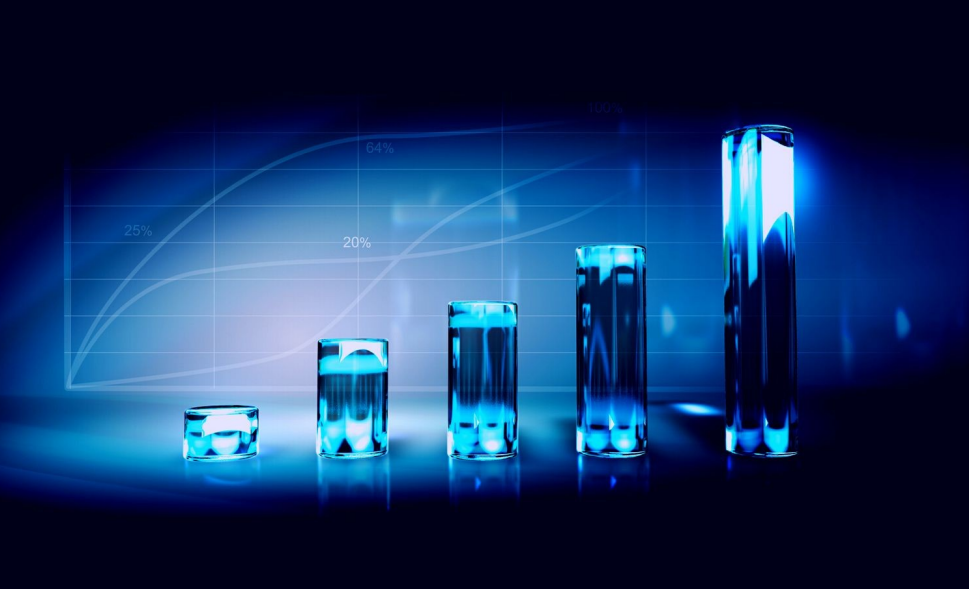

Open Source Program Offices

- Launched by European non profit organisations and concerned individuals to promote an approach to excellence in open source software management.

- Shares the values of the open source movement and believes that lowering barriers to open source adoption, contribution, and participation will help disseminate its benefits society-wide.

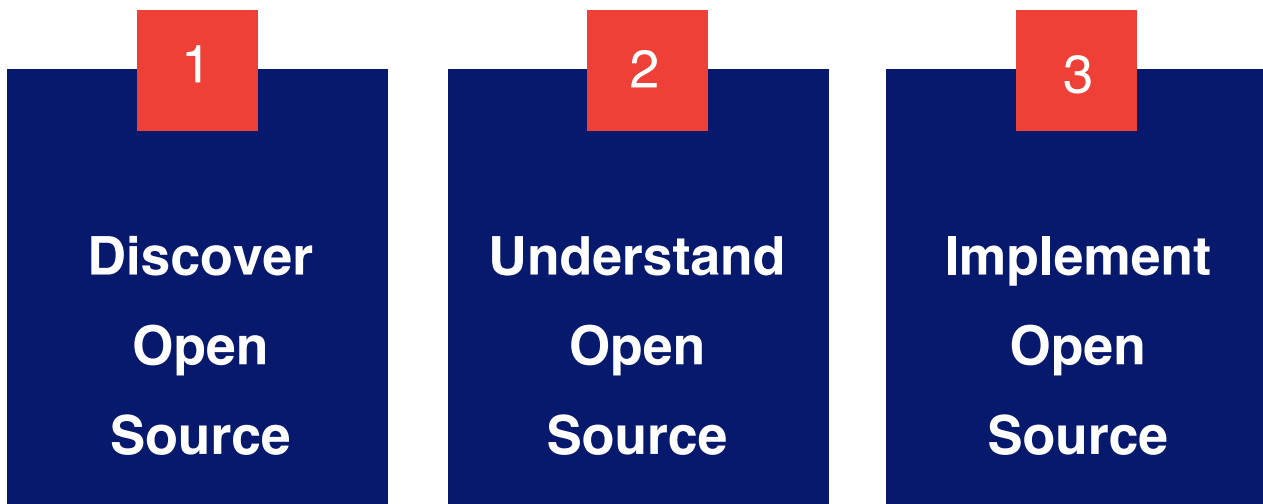
