Steering Committee – Francis Bordeleau

- Key points discussed in previous sections
- Budget
 - Summary of 2016 expenses
 - Co-sponsoring of the Welcome reception at MODELS 2016 conference with PolarSys
 - TM Forum Live Conference
 - Papyrus for Information Modeling
 - Co-developed by EclipseSource and CEA
 - European promotion trip
 - Met with 14 different organizations during the trip

Product Management Committee – Stephan Thesing/Charles Rivet

- Marketing
 - We now have a poster for Papyrus IC, including European format!
 - Factsheet is coming up
 - \circ ~ Same for wiki and website
 - \circ Need to agree on how to use the different websites (Papyrus, Papyrus IC) and wikis
- Papyrus IC website
 - Basic line: www.pyparus-ic.org main entry point for end-users and Papyrus based products
 - Plan in progress
 - o Comments
 - Sebastien G: Need to ensure consistency (looking feel) between the Papyrus and Papyrus IC
 - Charles: Also true for all "marketing" collaterals/aspects
- Product assessment/testing
 - Approach to assess maturity/usability/stability of different products (platform, SE, RT, ...) is being discussed
 - \circ $\$ Idea is management of development for industry-strength products
 - Member organizations have committed to contribute to the definition of the overall QA/testing process and to the testing of Papyrus 2.0 (and Papyrus and other related components in general)
- Review of Papyrus Product Status
 - o General
 - Needs to define proper naming for the different product areas
 - - •
 - Papyrus for Information Modeling (0.7)
 - Product Owner: Philip Langer (EclipseSource)
 - This is a major milestone as it is the first Papyrus solution/product funded by the Papyrus IC
 - First official version of Papyrus customized and packaged for specific subset of UML
 - Interested parties: Airbus Defence & Space, Airbus Helicopters, Ericsson, SDOs (TM Forum, MEF, ONF), Siemens, Spacebel, and many others
 - Papyrus for Information Modeling 0.7 will be officially available on Monday July 4th
 - Documentation is now available <u>here</u>
 - This documentation will be aligned with the general Papyrus documentation
 - People should use it as a starting point and contribute back to it
 - o Papyrus Platform
 - Product Owner: Sébastien Gérard (CEA)
 - Neon release Papyrus 2.0
 - Released last week as part of Eclipse Neon
 - We need to collect the set of potential requirements for Neon.1 and Neon.2 release
 - Will be properly tested by Papyrus IC members before being officially endorsed as "industry ready" by the Papyrus IC
 - Progressing well, but hasn't reach the required level of stability yet
 - It is a top responsibility of the Papyrus IC to ensure industrial quality!
 - Plan for Oxygen
 - Oxygen branch has been created in Gerrit

- Draft plan to be presented to the Papyrus IC PM committee at the beginning of July
- In the mid/long-term, we need to look at web-based and cloud support
- Migration of Papyrus from GEF 3.0 and GEF 4.0
- Papyrus-RT
 - Product Owner: Charles Rivet (Zeligsoft)
 - Progress
 - Release of Papyrus-RT 1.0 is postponed to later this year
 - Proposed plan for 0.8 and 0.9 (could be 1.0) has been posted on the <u>Papyrus-RT wiki</u> waiting for feedback
 - Papyrus-RT 0.8 will be released in at a date to be determined before end of September
 - Development of Rhapsody alternative based on Papyrus-RT
 - Based on the current evolution of Papyrus-RT, we now need to put a main focus the development of the Rhapsody alternative
 - Will work with the interested parties in the next weeks to define the plan
- Papyrus for System Engineering
 - Product Owner: Gert Johansson (Saab/Combitech)
 - Status
 - Evaluation workshop in Linköping on June 28th
 - 16 people participated to the workshop
 - o Included two demos
 - Peter C (Tieto): Papayrus-RT
 - Per J (Combitech/Saab): Papyrus for Information Modeling
 - A summary of the work done during the workshop will be produced
 - Includes main priorities
 - Very positive overall and very good networking opportunity
 - Participants: Combitech, Ericsson, Saab, Tieto, Volvo Cars, Volvo Trucks
 - Other organizations will also be involved, including Ericsson and Flanders make
- Papyrus for Enterprise Architecture
 - Product Owner: Thomas Wiman (Adocus)
 - Status
 - Working on overall plan definition
 - Need to get comments from interested parties regarding the email sent in April
 - Interested parties should contact Thomas W
- Papyrus for xtUML
 - Product Owner: Cort Starrett
 - Status
 - Working on overall plan definition
 - Relationship between xtUML and UML-RT

Architecture Committee – Remi Schnekenburger/Reibert Arbring

- Discussions around RCPTT/SWTBot
 - RCPTT: interesting for non-developers thanks to recorder. May (and should) be manually translated for product tests in SWTBot & Junit
 - \circ $\;$ How to share tests and reuse them in sub-components?
- Management of components in Papyrus
 - Ex: Migration in Papyrus project of the EMF compare/Papyrus integration
 - Feedback from "user day" in Sweden by Per J
 - o Google drive to store feedback on user experience

- Information modeling, and toolsmith guide on "how to".
 - Will also serve as a basis for study on customization of product for Papyrus (e.g. how to build a custom version of Information Modeling?)
- Meeting next week for Architecture committee to start discuss about items in the roadmap for Oxygen
 - o DSL Support & recursive customization
 - \circ $\;$ Technologies to describe diagram content and reuse definition of diagrams
 - o Usability
 - \circ Etc.
- Roadmap for Neon.1/2/3 & Oxygen
 - o Stabilization and usability
 - o Open question on means to track usability improvements
