Hackathon Update

Hackathon overlaps with Bosch Connected World. There will be two other hackathons at the same time. Are we focussing on app development, or growing an ecosystem? There will be a number of challenges that can look at both aspects. We do need to define the challenges soon.

Is there work we could do setting up an EclipseCon hackathon to bootstrap the BCW hackathon? Question - is there value in having one in October and a second in November. Agree the timing is not ideal, but the participants should be different. EclipseCon could be about building the technical infrastructure for the BCW event?

Do we need to go wide with sponsors for the event? The feeling is that it should be restricted to SDV members. Each of the members listed need to go internally now to get approval, the cost should be in the range 10k -> 15k Euro. We will discuss next week what the sponsorship package will look like.

Update on contribution day, currently ~40 for onsite. It would be good to get this higher. If there is a preference for order of presentations, please let Michael know.
