- 7. The Program Plan must be approved by the Executive Director.
- 8. The Steering Committee shall share the Program Plan with Working Group Participants.
- 9. The Steering Committee drives and monitors the progress of the implementation of the Program Plan.

# **Strategies and Tactics**

## **Project Support**

### **Corresponding Strategies and Tactics**

#### 1. Start Project Infrastructure and Lab Subcommittee

- Determine tools (e.g., CI/CD) and infrastructure that could support multiple projects
- Determine what Lab Facilities or Test Bed Facilities would be appropriate

#### 2. Organize Contribution Day(s)

- Encourage existing members to begin Eclipse projects with existing projects
- Leverage industry and WG research to find and encourage new candidate projects to Eclipse
- Provide a welcoming environment that attracts new innovation-focused projects
- Target the first Contribution Day for end of June or early July

#### 3. Increase Support for Emerging Projects

- Map out the journey and relationships to link projects together
- Determine relevant specifications



### **Innovation**

### **Corresponding Strategies and Tactics**

#### 1. Observe, Anticipate and Help Drive Industry Trends

- Ensure WG messaging stays relevant to industry leading innovation
- Determine WG research plan to benefit our members and community
- Provide a welcoming environment that attracts new innovation-focused projects

#### 2. Pursue Technology and Partner Integrations

- Identify tools and APIs to integrate with our platform
- Facilitate relationships between projects and technology partners

#### 3. Nurture Differentiation in New Technology Sectors

- Create an environment that encourages innovation at the project level
- In collaboration with project leads, investigate new technology areas, e.g. AI/ML and Edge
- Map out a content strategy that demonstrates innovation

#### 4. Make Security a "Day Zero" Priority

- Promote transparent and timely practices around security
- Work with project leads to identify/implement current and new security features
- Build story of why and how products built on our platforms enhances security

#### 1. Execute an SEO-friendly Content Plan

- Case studies

#### 2. Support Virtual and In-Person Events

- Organize Contribution Days
- Organize a Dev Summit Day in conjunction with EclipseCon October 2022
- Increase WG representation as presenters at in-person events

#### 3. Acquire and/or Generate Relevant and Timely Market Intelligence

- 2022 SDV Developer Survey
- Publish articles about market trends and their relation to WG technologies
- Create opportunities for members to discuss market trends

#### 4. Design a Great Onboarding Experience

- Audit project docs to ensure a great experience for new contributors/adopters
- Improve project onboarding tutorials
- Highlight stories around new community members and contributors



## **Community**

### **Corresponding Strategies and Tactics**

#### 1. Community Meetups (in-person)

- Conduct Working Group planning day at EclipseCon for all Members
- Include open sessions for adopters and contributors
- Virtual option for broader community participation

#### 2. Expand Upon the Component Model for Growth and Innovation

- Establish SDV.Dev, SDV.Ops, SDV.Edge SIGs
- Work with stakeholders to explore other SIG topics

#### 3. Grow our Community Channels

- Use WG Slack channel for events to increase workspace members
- Run experiments to grow Twitter and LinkedIn followers
- Post more frequently to mailing list to promote engagement

#### 4. Increase Membership

- Utilize SIGs to attract new members
- Publish member stories and case studies
- Quarterly WG check-ins to discuss membership
