Content Finalization

The committee discussed and agreed upon requirements in order to finalize the program plan. Slide 12 of the Deck (Marketing Activities) was revised. By doing so, the Steering Committee is now able to determine the affordability of the budget and where member contributions will be required to meet objectives/deliverables. It was agreed that project creations is an important area to focus on which will then enable outward marketing via social media (tweeting, blogging, etc.) in order to remain as attractive as possible to technologists by demonstrating tangible deliverables (real value) in order to increase membership.

Member Contributions CALL to ACTION

Based on the current budget the Steering Committee must work to define ways other members can contribute based on the program plan. Navin agreed to write up communication to invite members to contribute which he will share with the Steering Committee in order to set up a call to discuss this initiative.

It should be noted in the communication the specific contributions that IOTA is making to the Working Group itself in terms of program management of the Tangle EE Eclipse projects as well as the Steering Committee.
