## [Program plan update](#)

The Steering Committee did some further adjustments about the content creation section, under Marketing Activities. The content created by the Tangle EE members should land on the website, to ensure that the website stays fresh. The most comprehensive way would be to set up a blog post section on the website. It might need maintenance, but if it is worth it, the front-end developers could set up the section. Another possibility would be to have a manually updated feed with blog posts about Tangle EE.

In addition it might be possible to use a specific hashtag on Twitter, to ensure that every post related to Tangle EE is captured under the hashtag. If possible, the website could portrait the last 10 tweets, tweeted with the hashtag.

Since the budget is compact for Tangle EE, it predominantly goes to fund the Eclipse Foundation work on behalf of Tangle EE. An outline of what the Eclipse Foundation contributes with the money, will be presented as the budget for Tangle EE.

Action Item: Paul Buck will speak to Paul White, about giving an overview of what the Eclipse Foundation are spending the budget on.
